Committee on Democracy, Governance and Human Rights will submit to the Assembly of Heads of State and Government one consolidated resolution of the agenda topic. The consolidated resolution on the topic will be based on draft resolutions previously submitted and sponsored according to the rules.)

Silencing the guns through building resilient democracies, discouraging coup d'états, and supporting accountable governance.

COMMITTEE ON ECONOMIC MATTERS (The Committee on Economic Matters will submit to the Assembly of Heads of State and Government one consolidated resolution of the agenda topic. The consolidated resolution on the topic will be based on draft resolutions previously submitted and sponsored according to the rules.)

Leveraging Africa's economic power in the global economy and strengthening Africa's role in global trade negotiations.
